Fulbright Student Grants to France: ENS Rennes

Graduating college seniors and bachelor's degree holders may apply to complete a master's degree at the prestigious and highly competitive Grand Ecole, Ecole normale supérieure de Rennes (ENS Rennes).

One award will be given to a candidate in the humanities or social sciences, and one award will be given to a candidate in the fundamental or applied sciences.

ELIGIBLE FIELDS	Fundamental sciences, social sciences, applied sciences, humanities (especially law, economics, management, computer science, telecommunications, mathematics, mechatronics, sports science and physical education). Please note that candidates in the legal field must have already obtained an undergraduate degree in Law.

LENGTH OF AWARDS	Up to 24 months
BENEFITS (MAINTENANCE AND TRAVEL)	€1000 per month and a full tuition waiver from ENS Rennes. An additional €300 per month from the Franco-American Fulbright Commission, as well as a €1,200 travel allowance.
HOW TO APPLY	<p>First step: Interested candidates should contact both the ENS Rennes International Office and the department head or laboratory director in their respective fields to present their research or study project and to obtain an affiliation.</p> <p>Second step: Apply to the Fulbright Student Program through the International Institute of Education (IIE) (http://us.fulbright.online.org).</p>
